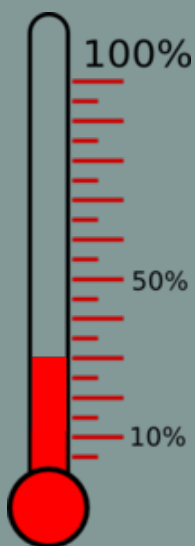
Finally! Fishing!

Pool Dues will stay the same this year, at \$150.00 per family for an all-season pass to the pool. In addition to the season pass, we will be offering weekend passes to residents who don’t make use of the pool during the entire season. Weekend Passes will be \$25.00 plus a fully refundable \$25.00 deposit for the keys.

As always, regardless of the type of pass you purchase, pool use is restricted to paid members and their guests only, and all pool use rules must be followed at all times.

The BBQ will be free and is open to all residents and their immediate families. We will serve Hotdogs, Hamburgers, side dishes, but no alcohol will be offered.

We hope to see you on the 24th, for the food, free swimming, and your signup for the pool! In addition, there will be a collection jar for donations to the building maintenance fund. Please donate to this worthy cause!
